

Job Description: Head Lifeguard

Purpose: To monitor and oversee the pool and waterfront, providing leadership to this area of camp.

Responsible to: Executive Director(s), Ministry Director, and Program Director(s)

Wage: \$382/week

Qualifications: Applicants must be at least 18 years old by the start of the camp season and have an active, growing relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. Applicants must hold a current NLS Certification, CPR level C, and Aquatic Emergency Care certificate (or equivalents). It is ideal if the head lifeguard has taken their Pool Operators course.

Beneficial Skills:

- Able to provide clear, direct, authoritative leadership.
- A meticulous attitude towards cleaning and testing pool area.
- Able to teach safety procedures to a team of lifeguards, providing correction and coaching when necessary.
- Self-motivated.

Responsibilities:

- Be responsible for the pool and waterfront and all related activities.
- Check pool area and equipment regularly and report to Director(s) any maintenance needs at once.
- Care for and keep in place all safety equipment.
- Establish a safety check system for general swim times. Acquaint all campers and leaders with the system and enforce it.
- Conduct a swim test for all campers before their first swim time. When complete send list to the office.
- Conduct regular cleaning and maintenance of the pools, pool areas, and waterfront.
- A written evaluation of the pool activities and facilities must be left with the Executive Director(s) at the end of the summer. This must include any materials or equipment to be ordered before the next summer.
- When not supervising or maintaining the pool, the lifeguard must actively participate in all other areas of camp program.
- Ensure other lifeguards are involved in main camp program when they are not needed.
- Adhere to the One Hope Canada and KLBC Statement of Faith, Code of Conduct and Summer Missionary Expectations.
- Mentor 3-4 summer missionaries, including being mentored by a superior.
- Perform any other tasks at the request of the Directors.
