

Job Description: Early Years Assistant

Purpose: To gain experience in camp ministry by assisting the Early Years Program Director in providing leadership to a group of assigned children while further developing one's own relationship with God.

Responsible to: Early Years Program Director, Program Director(s), Ministry Director, and Executive Director(s).

Wage: Volunteer

Qualifications:

- Preference will be given to those who are at least 15 years by the start of the camp season or those having served in our BOLD program.
- 14 year old applicants must have completed our BOLD program.
- Applicants must have an active, growing relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

Beneficial Skills:

- Ability to communicate well with both adults and children.
- Good people skills, able to provide a friendly, helpful attitude when dealing with children and their parents.
- Energetic and caring attitude towards young children.

Responsibilities:

- Assist the Early Years Program Director in giving leadership and providing care to the children in the Early Years Program.
- Assist in leading age appropriate crafts and Bible story times, ensuring a strong emphasis on spiritual development.
- May be responsible for children of kitchen volunteers during meal times.
- Assist in directing activity periods as scheduled.
- When responsibilities with the Early Years program are complete, must be actively involved in all areas of the main camp program.
- Must attend Junior meetings.
- Meet with assigned mentor on a weekly basis.
- Adhere to the One Hope Canada and KLBC Statement of Faith, Code of Conduct and Summer Missionary Expectations.
- Perform any other tasks at the request of the Directors.
