Job Description: Junior Cabin Leader

Purpose: To gain experience in camp ministry by assisting a Cabin Leader in providing leadership to a group of assigned campers while further developing one's own relationship with God.

Responsible to: Cabin Leader, Ministry Director, Program Director(s), and Executive Director(s)

Wage: Volunteer, when assigned to lead a skill will receive \$50/skill

Qualifications:

- Preference will be given to those who are at least 15 years by the start of the camp season or those having served in our BOLD program.
- 14 year old applicants must have completed our BOLD program.
- Applicants must have an active, growing relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

Responsibilities:

- Assist a Cabin Leader in giving leadership to a cabin of campers.
- Lead at least one evening devotion time during the week (Prepared ahead of time)
- Assist a Cabin Leader in teaching skills during each day of camp. In rare occasions may be asked to be the main leader of a skill.
- Assist in directing activity periods as scheduled.
- Take part in all aspects of the camp program with energy and enthusiasm.
- Work with the Cabin Leader in providing direction, care, discipline, and counselling to the campers.
- Assist Cabin Leader with camper evaluations and postcards.
- Must attend all Junior meetings.
- May serve as Early Years Assistant (see separate job description for details).
- Meet with assigned mentor on a weekly basis.
- Adhere to the One Hope Canada and KLBC Statement of Faith, Code of Conduct and Summer Missionary Expectations.
- Perform any other tasks at the request of the Directors.
