

# Job Description: BOLD Program Leader

**Purpose:** To provide leadership and mentorship to the BOLD program campers.

**Responsible to:** Ministry Director and Executive Director(s).

**Wage:** \$425/week

**Qualifications:** Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and be working on or have a high school diploma. One year of biblical studies is beneficial but not necessary. Applicants must have an active, growing relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. Priority will be given to those having spent time working with teens and those who have previous summer camp work experience.

## **Beneficial Skills:**

- Because a large portion of this position is spent mentoring and coaching BOLD campers, applicants should enjoy listening to concerns and questions and have the patience to spend time caring for those they are responsible for.
- A flexible attitude that is willing to take on a variety of duties, recognizing that at times they will be asked to perform less desirable tasks.
- Experience in providing appropriate correction to children and youth.
- Comfortable and able to teach in one-on-one situations and in small groups.

## **Responsibilities:**

- Provide overall leadership, direction and care to the BOLD program and its campers.
- To co-ordinate with the Director(s) to determine the work projects for the week.
- Meet daily with the Director(s) to discuss the progress on projects and work details.
- Plan Bible studies based on and the material provided.
- To spend time encouraging the BOLD campers and praying with them.
- Plan outlines for getting conversation/discussion started during one-on-one mentoring times.
- With feed-back from the campers, and after co-ordinating with the Ministry Director, plan fun activities for the BOLD campers for each day.
- Provide direction as BOLD campers assist in leading evening games, chapels, campfires etc.
- Keep Directors updated on the feedback, issues, and questions leaders come across throughout the program.
- Attend summer missionary meetings.
- Attend weekly meetings with mentor.
- Adhere to the One Hope Canada and KLBC Statement of Faith, Code of Conduct and Summer Missionary Expectations.
- Perform any other tasks at the request of the Directors.
